Civil Rights Project Sisak The Civil Rights Project Sisak (CRP Sisak) is a non-governmental, non-political, unprofitable, humanitarian organisation, registered in Sisak on 2 December 2003. CRP Sisak continues the work of the Civil Rights Project of the Norwegian Refugee Council (NRC).

Our goals The goal of the organisation is promotion and protection of human rights and fundamental values of citizens, development of democratic political culture and development of local communities, development of civil society, encouragement of social partnerships and intersectoral dialogue, development of intersectoral and sectoral cooperation at local and international level, fight against unequal treatment and all types of discrimination, fight against corruption, fight against poverty and social exclusion and provision of humanitarian aid.

Our activities CRP Sisak provides free legal aid to the clients directly after they approach the office. It is not necessary to fill in any requests or forms or to wait for their applications to be solved. It is enough to come to any of our offices or contact us at any of our contacts. Up to date, CRP successfully advised over 20 000 clients. The free legal aid provided by CRP consists of:

- Providing of free legal advices
- Providing of general legal information
- Advocacy and encouragement of society changes
- Writing of submissions to relevant institutions

CRP Sisak started to work independently in 2004, after the withdrawal of NRC from Croatia. Therefore, from 1999 until today, CRP has been providing legal aid in continuity, including providing of in court representation to returnees, refugees, internally displaced persons, national minorities and other socially vulnerable population.

In order to achieve its goals, besides its independent work, CRP Sisak works within different networks and coordination (Platform 112, BURA – network for fighting against corruption, ENAR – network for fighting against racism, etc.) CRP also founded some coordinations, such as “Together for Justice”, “Local Platform for Roma” and “Platform 044 – for better future of Sisak-Moslavina County”.

CRP Sisak has been an implementing partner of **UNHCR** since 2011 and a regional contact point for fighting against discrimination of the **Ombudsman** for Central Croatia since 2012.

CRP Sisak has been implementing the most of its projects, depending on the aim and activities, in partnerships with different national and international civil society organisations, institutions and local and regional self-governments, as well as with United Nations agencies.

Besides its main office in Sisak, CRP receives clients in its field offices. The field offices cover almost whole Sisak-Moslavina County and a part of Karlovac County. Also, CRP has had a mobile team, which goes to the field when necessary. The mobile team staff provide legal and other necessary assistance to citizens on the spot. Furthermore, CRP Sisak organises public debates and group counselling when necessary, i.e. when some changes in society or in legislation could negatively influence on citizens.

represents a novelty in providing of free legal aid in the Republic of Croatia. While some similar services have machines, free legal phone of CRP enables citizens to directly speak with legal advisers.



CRP Sisak

provides free legal advices in all legal areas and problems. There is no scheduling of appointments, but you get free legal aid directly and immediately.



Besides counselling and informing of citizens, CRP provides its clients with services of writing of different types of submissions. Applications, requests, complaints, appeals and lawsuits related to their cases, citizens may obtain for free. CRP Sisak has a contract with an attorney in Sisak, who provides in court representation to clients in specific cases.
