The Civil Rights Project Sisak /CRP Sisak, in cooperation with the Civic Initiative "My City Sisak" is implementing a two-year project „**DIDI: Two-way Dynamic Integration**“ from 1 March 2024 to 28 February 2026. The project is financed by **the Ministry of Labor, Pension System, Family and Social Policy**. The main goal of the project is to provide support in the integration into the community of persons with granted international protection in the Sisak-Moslavina and Karlovac counties.

One of the activities **during the first year of implementation** was to provide permanent support and legal/administrative assistance to **53 persons** with granted international protection, both directly through work with beneficiaries in the offices of the CRP Sisak in Sisak and Karlovac, as well as through info points in the field, a free info phone, and through field visits to beneficiaries

During 2024, CRP Sisak organized four **educational workshops** on the topic of promoting understanding and tolerance and on ways to better compete in the labor market, writing resumes, using online tools for finding employment /social networks, online platforms/, etc. Two meetings were also organized for the purpose of economic and emotional empowerment. **Hygiene support packages** were distributed to users, both those who attended the trainings, workshops and meetings, and those in the field.

CRP Sisak created and printed **information leaflets** for international protection applicants, and distributed it through direct work with users in the CRP Sisak office premises and in the field during the duration of the project.

During the second year of implementation of the CRP Sisak, in addition to the most common activity of providing permanent legal and administrative support, conducted 2 workshops entitled "How to compete better on the labor market" in Sisak, as well as held 2 meetings/social gatherings for the purpose of economic and emotional empowerment, one of which was held in Sisak and the other in Karlovac.

CRP Sisak also held 3 half-day educational workshops entitled "Through Understanding and Tolerance to Unity", which were held on 9th October 2025 in Popovača and 8th December 2025 in Hrvatska Dubica. An additional educational workshop due to increased interest was held on 27th January 2026 in Hrvatska Dubica. Students from primary schools of Zorka Sever, Popovača and Ivo Kozarčanin, Hrvatska Dubica had the opportunity to learn about the asylum system in the Republic of Croatia, as well as the issues that persons with granted international protection face. The third workshop was held after the fulfillment of contractual obligations, and due to the great interest of the staff of the Primary School Ivo Kozarčanin to further educate pupils on the aforementioned topic.



On 20th June 2025, CRP Sisak with the partner association Most Perna marked the World Refugee Day in Topusko as part of the 12th Refugees Week. The Municipality of Topusko is a border area where migrant movements take place, and we took this opportunity to highlight to the local community the importance of integrating persons who have been granted international protection, which is closely linked to mass migration.

We also gathered with third-country nationals who live and work with us in the local community and discussed their needs. We familiarized them on how the asylum system is currently acceptable in Croatia. We informed the residents of the Municipality that accepting foreigners into the local community is essential for their integration, without prejudice or discrimination. We also shared our promotional materials.

During the second year of implementation, we held regular meetings with the partner, as well as project activities, joint media and advocacy activities in the community, as well as all other activities related to beneficiaries.

During the two-year project implementation, CRP Sisak continuously provided support and legal and administrative assistance to a total of **104 beneficiaries**. **120 beneficiaries** participated in workshops and gatherings, while **141 pupils and primary school teachers** participated in the training "Through Understanding and Tolerance to Unity". **30 hygiene support packages** were also distributed.

In conclusion, after the successful implementation of the two-year project „DIDI: Two-way Dynamic Integration“ and the submission of the annual report, CRP Sisak applied to the call of the Ministry of Labor, Pension System, Family and Social Policy to implement new two-year programs aimed at reducing and preventing social exclusion, as well as social inclusion and integration of socially vulnerable groups during 2026 and 2027.

We continue to remain open to all persons with granted international protection from the territory of the Republic of Croatia. In case of ambiguities or difficulties related to the
